GUIDANCE ON USE OF ALFENTANIL INFUSIONS

Drug details

- An opioid analgesic with rapid onset and short duration of action
- Metabolised in the liver, so safer in renal failure than other opioids
- Only available as injection (although this preparation can be used sublingually)
- Ten times more potent than diamorphine

Indications

- · Opioid of choice in renal failure
- Intolerance of other opioids

Side effects

As for morphine

Dose

- 1/30th of daily total oral morphine dose (1/15th of daily total subcutaneous morphine dose), via syringe driver over 24 hrs
- Use fentanyl for breakthrough
- Fentanyl is five times stronger than alfentanil
- Breakthrough dose is 1/8th of daily fentanyl as it is a longer acting drug than other opioids
- Fentanyl breakthrough dose is therefore 1/40th of the 24hour alfentanil dose

Example conversion

- 45mg bd oral morphine
- = 90mg oral morphine/24 hours
- = 3mg sc alfentanil/24 hrs
- =breakthrough dose of 75mcg fentanyl sc
