STARTING OR ROTATING TO METHADONE

Loading Dose

Is the patient STRONG OPIOID naïve?

→ **YES**, Load with 1mg Methadone

▶ **NO** i.e. **on a** STRONG OPIOID?

Load 1/10 of 24-hour total morphine equivalent dose.

★Example: (Zomorph 20mg BD = total 40mg i.e. loading dose = 4mg)

NEVER prescribe more than 30mg regardless of total Opioid in 24 hours

Regular Dose-

Half Loading Dose to be given every 12 hours.

 \bigstar (See above example: $\frac{1}{2}$ of 4 mg = 2mg twice daily)

PRN Dose

1/8 of Total Daily Dose

 \bigstar (See above example – 1/8 of 4 mg = 0.5mg **2-3 hourly**

Maintain regular and PRN doses until: REVIEW on Day 5/6

- ❖ Add up all Breakthrough doses over last 48 hours (2 days), divide by 4 and add to both AM & PM regular dose
- * Recalculate your rescue dose as 1/8 of the new total daily dose.
