

Trouble Shooting

Syringe Drivers – If you are having problems with your syringe driver, check this list for a possible solution.

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	ACTION
Infusion won't start	Incorrect positioning of battery	Check battery position
Pump functioning, but light not flashing	Battery flat/low	Replace battery
Infusion too slow or too fast, or has stopped	Dislodged syringe	Check and reattach syringe
	Tubing kinked	Ensure tubing is free from kinks – change if necessary
	Blocked needle (drugs have crystallised, white particles along tubing)	Replace needle and line, and re-site. Check drug concentration and compatibility. See drug information or check with pharmacy
	Site of infusion red/swollen	Change site
	Infusion incorrectly set	Check rate at which driver is set. Ensure correct for volume of drug
	Machine wet, e.g. accidentally in shower	Change driver
	Has the driver been dropped?	Change driver
You hear an alarm	On insertion of the battery	Do nothing this is normal
	On starting the infusion by pressing the start button	Continue, this is normal.
	The infusion is complete!	Recharge the driver for the next 24 hours.
	A blockage in the tubing	Ensure the tubing is free from kinks or if crystallisation is seen – re-site with new cannula and tubing. Check dilution and drug compatibility
	Discharging battery	Discard and replace with new driver.

 $\underline{\text{NOTE}}$ If syringe driver is changed due to malfunction, then it should be returned to: **PALLIATIVE CARE**, clearly marked with problem.

^{**}In all cases where problems have occurred then it should be noted on syringe driver infusion chart and appropriate action taken.**
