PATIENT INFORMATION AVAILABLE FOR MEDICATION MANAGEMENT POLICY

PURPOSE	This policy is to provide guidelines for patient information available to health care providers involved in the medication management of the patient.
POLICY STATEMENT	Information about the patient available to health care providers involved in medication management includes the following: Patient's Sex Patient's Age Patient's Current Medications Patient's Diagnoses, Comorbidities, and Concurrently Occurring Conditions Patient's Allergies and Past Sensitivities Weight and height (as appropriate) Pregnancy and Lactation (Breast Feeding) Status (as appropriate)
	Such information is accessible to health care providers involved in medication management (except in emergency situations when time does not permit). Note: The resources for this information include the patient medical record, Clinic Station, Mosaic Systems, Pharmacy Patient Profile, and Patient Medication Administration Report/Record (MAR).
SCOPE	This policy covers all patients at M.D. Anderson Cancer Center.

PATIENT INFORMATION AVAILABLE FOR MEDICATION MANAGEMENT PROCEDURE

Patient information	1.	Patient specific information is available to health care providers involved in the medication management of patients. Such information is accessible to health care providers involved in medication management (except in emergency situations when time does not permit).		
Information Resources	2.	Resources for this information include the patient medical record, Clinic Station and Mosaic Systems, Pharmacy Patient Profile, and Patient Medication Administration Record.		
	3.	Information about the patient available to health care providers and the resource(s) for the information include, but are not limited to the following:		
		 Patient's Sex – Medical Record, Clinic Station, Patient Addressograph Plate Patient's Age-Medical Record, Clinic Station, Patient Addressograph Plate (date of birth) Patient's Current Medications – Medical Record/Physician's orders/Medication Administration Record, Clinic Station Patient's Diagnoses, Comorbidities, Concurrently 		
		 Occurring Conditions – Medical Record/H&P/Progress Notes/etc., Clinic Station Patient's Allergies and Past Sensitivities – Medical Record/Allergy record/admitting orders/H&P/clinic notes, Clinic Station, Pharmacy Computer System Weight and height (as appropriate) – Medical Record, Clinic Station, Pharmacy Computer System Pregnancy and Lactation (Breast Feeding) Status (as appropriate) – Medical Record/H&P/Admission assessment 		
Responsible Personnel	4.	Health care providers are to access and provide updates to patient specific information within their scope of practice.
